Although, the session states 7:00 am, classes begin at 8:00 am, with a morning devotional. Morning classes end at 11:55 am, daily. Lunch time begins at 12:00 pm, and children can bring their own lunch, or order from our hot lunch program.

Our afternoon session begins at 12:00 pm, and ends at 6:00 pm. After 6:00 pm, the fee will be \$1.00, per minute past 6:00 pm.

Afternoon activities can include: Water Days, Bikes and Scooters Days, Crafting, Sports Activities, Lego Building, Puzzle Making, and many more fun activities.

Field Trips may be: Walking field trips to the nearby parks, Bowling, Ice Skating, San Diego Zoo, and more as they become available. **All of the field trips are an extra fee and the fee depends on what each entity charges.**

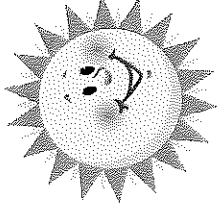
Program packets will be available soon, and we hope that *your* family will join *our* family, for a joyous and Christ-filled summer of learning and fun!

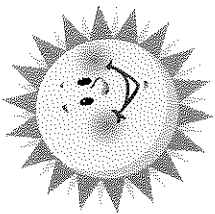

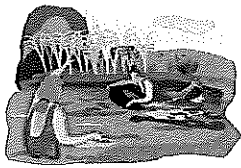

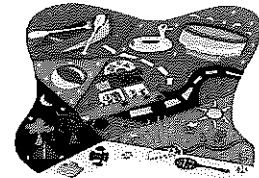

FIELD TRIP SAFETY STANDARDS FOR PRIVATELY OWNED VEHICLES

- A. The driver and each passenger must use a fixed seat belt. Children under the age of 8 or 4'9" must be secured in a car seat or booster seat in the back seat. No doubling up on seat belts. A child may not sit in a seat with an air bag.
- B. The vehicle is serviced regularly, is in safe operating condition, and is equipped with a first aid kit, blanket and spare tire.
- C. Driver agrees to obey the speed limit.
- D. Trucks or trailers are never used for transporting students except as seat belted passengers in the cab.
- E. The driver is currently licensed and carries at least the minimum insurance required by the state of California.
- F. If a vehicle designated by the manufacturer for carrying 10 or more passengers is used, the driver must hold a valid Class II driver's license (state law). The license holder must also have a valid medical certificate not more than two years old.

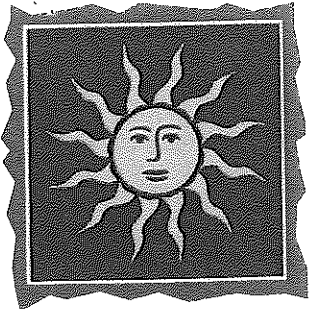

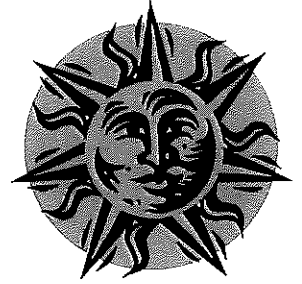

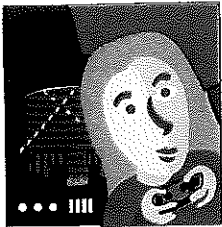

ELECTRONIC PERMISSION SLIP

In order for your child to bring ANY of their electronics from home, they will need to have their name marked on EVERY ITEM they want to bring. Parents buy a lot of the same electronic hand held devices, so mark children's names legibly and use permanent markers. Children bring a lot of similar games and when one child leaves a game laying on a table, another child may automatically assume it is their game and pick it up. Later, it can become chaotic trying to figure out which game belongs to each child, unless they are clearly labeled! Thank you for giving this matter your 'SPECIAL ATTENTION'.

Children may bring cell phones, **but will only be able to communicate with their parents.** They will not be allowed to chat, or text, with friends and classmates. If a parent wants to call to check on a child, the child may answer. **If a parent needs to be called, the child will need to get permission from an adult staff member, to make the call. No phones will be allowed on field trips.**

Christ the Cornerstone Academy nor any of our staff will be held responsible for any electronics, games, phones, chargers or any other electronic accessories brought to school. THEY WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENTS AND THEIR CHILDREN. We also reserve the right to decide who loses this privilege, due to being irresponsible, or repeated behavioral issues. Bringing electronics to school is a privilege, not a right.

Summer Supplies List

Welcome to Christ the Cornerstone Academy's Summer Program. We have a lot of fun activities planned, so your child(ren), will need to bring in various daily supplies.

ON WATER DAYS: Flip-flops (To be worn ONLY while playing in the water), SUNSCREEN, water bottles (We do not supply bottled water), hats, and a change of clothes. We do not supply sunscreen.

BOWLING TRIPS: Socks for shoe rental, and money for the snack bar, if parents choose to let them participate.

ICE SKATING TRIPS: Long socks for skate rental, long pants, long sleeved shirts, jackets, and gloves. You can pack this for the children, and during lunch time they can change into the warmer clothing. When we return, they can change back into cooler clothing. It will be hot outside.

ON ELECTRONICS DAYS: Please, be sure to put children's names on ALL electronics they bring, including power cords. Children have a lot of the same games and equipment. It is very easy for them to grab the wrong one, if they are placed on a table.

ON ARTS & CRAFTS DAYS: Old clothes and shoes would be best. It can get pretty messy creating works of art!

Please, write children's names, or initials, on ALL items. Children can leave a lot of clothing, toys, etc., laying around, and it makes it much easier to make sure the clothing gets returned if it is marked with names.

All of our field trips are dependent on volunteer drivers and chaperones. If each parent could volunteer for two field trips during the summer, we should never have to cancel our trips due to transportation issues.

In addition, the field trips, which are NOT walking, but driving trips, there will be an additional charge for those trips, depending on fees charged by the vendors. An example would be, if I am able to get an educational field trip to the San Diego Zoo, they charge a fee, per person. It is, usually, a much lower fee (i.e. \$15-\$20, per child, versus \$52-\$62), when we go as a school.
