Summer is fast approaching and we, here at Christ the Cornerstone Academy (CTCA), are making plans for your children to keep their educational skills sharp, and to have them engage with the many different activities we have to offer.

Our school offers a morning academic program, which WILL RUN FROM JUNE 10, 2024 – AUGUST 2, 2024. The morning sessions are designed to review age appropriate materials in Reading, Math, Science, Art, Music, and Enrichment classes.

Before school care is from 7:30 am – 8:00 am. Classes begin at 8:00 am, with a Morning Devotional. We have snack time 10 am -10:30 am, which includes a short recess. (Children need to bring their own snack from home, please.) Morning classes end at 12:00 pm, daily. Lunch time begins at 12:00 pm. Children need to bring their own lunches.

Our afternoon session begins at 12:00 pm, and ends at 5:30 pm. Afternoon activities can include: Water Days, Arts & Crafts, Electronics Days, Movie Days, Sporting Activities, Lego Building, Puzzle Making, and many more fun activities.

Field Trips may be: Swimming, Bowling, Ice Skating, The San Diego Zoo, walking field trips to nearby parks and the Mira Mesa Library.

Program packets will be handed out to our currently enrolled students, and are available for non-enrolled CTCA students on our website at ctc-academy.org or on the Gradlink registration page.

We hope that *your* family will join *our* family, for a joyous and Christ-filled summer of learning and fun!

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Dear Summer Program Parents,

Summer is coming very soon and, before you know it, it will be time to sign up for our Summer Program.

We are working very hard to plan and coordinate our Summer Program so we can get it out to you in March.

This year we have a new process to enroll in our Summer Program. It is called Gradelink, and it is a great new way to, not only enroll, but to view and pay your monthly statement. It will also allow you to pay your statement with a debit card or credit card, with a 3% processing fee, or ACH, which has no extra fee. In the past, you would only be able to use cash or check, so this is a fantastic new opportunity for our parents.

In addition, once you have enrolled in Gradelink, you will not have to fill out the same forms next year. We can simply re-activate your account if you choose to return next summer.

All necessary forms can be found on Gradelink and can be submitted electronically or in person to the School Office.

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Summer Supplies List

Welcome to Christ the Cornerstone Academy's Summer Program. We have a lot of fun activities planned, so your child(ren), will need to bring in various daily supplies.

WATER DAYS: Flip-flops (To be worn ONLY while playing in the water), SUNSCREEN, water bottles (We do not supply bottled water), hats, and a change of clothes. We do not supply sunscreen, and we have a drinking fountain for children to refill their water bottles. We do not supply bottled water.

SWIMMING TRIPS: Please, bring swimwear only. Your child may wear their swimsuit under their street clothes, but street clothes are not allowed to go into the pool. Bring sunscreen, water bottle, hat, towel and pool shoes/flip-flops. (Flip-flops can only be worn to and from the pool. They are not allowed on our school campus due to safety concerns.)

BOWLING TRIPS: Socks for shoe rental, and money for the snack bar, if parents choose to let them participate.

ICE SKATING TRIPS: Long socks for skate rental, long pants, long sleeved shirts, jackets, and gloves. You can pack this for the children, and during lunch time they can change into the warmer clothing. When we return, they can change back into cooler clothing. It will be hot outside.

ON ELECTRONICS DAYS: Please, be sure to put children's names on ALL electronics they bring, including power cords. Children have a lot of the same games and equipment. It is very easy for them to grab the wrong one, if they are placed on a table.

ON ARTS & CRAFTS DAYS: Old clothes and shoes would be best. It can get pretty messy creating works of art!

Please, write children's names, or initials, on ALL items. Children can leave a lot of clothing, toys, etc., lying around, and it makes it much easier to make sure the clothing gets returned if it is marked with names.

All of our field trips are dependent on volunteer drivers and chaperones. If each parent could volunteer for two field trips during the summer, we should never have to cancel our field trips due to transportation issues.

CTCA Summer Program Electronics Policy

In order for your child to bring ANY of their electronics from home, they will need to have their name marked on EVERY ITEM they want to bring. Parents buy a lot of the same electronic handheld devices, so mark children's names legibly and use permanent markers. Children bring a lot of similar games and when one child leaves a game laying on a table, another child may automatically assume it is their game and pick it up. Later, it can become chaotic trying to figure out which game belongs to each child, unless they are clearly labeled! Thank you for giving this matter your 'SPECIAL ATTENTION'.

Children may bring cell phones but will only be able to communicate with their parents. They will not be allowed to chat, or text, with friends and classmates. If a parent wants to call to check on a child, the child may answer. If a parent needs to be called the child will need to get permission from an adult staff member to make the call. No phones will be allowed on field trips.

Christ the Cornerstone Academy nor any of our staff will be held responsible for any electronics, games, phones, chargers, or any other electronic accessories brought to school. **THEY WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENTS AND THEIR CHILDREN.** We also reserve the right to decide who loses this privilege, due to being irresponsible, or repeated behavioral issues. Bringing electronics to school is a privilege, not a right.

I understand Christ the Cornerstone Academy nor any of their staff accepts responsibility for any broken, lost, misplaced, or stolen electronics which my child has chosen to bring to school.

With this in mind, if you are in agreement with our electronics policy and intend to send your child with personal electronic devices, please consent by selecting yes on the summer program registration form.

CTCA Summer Program Sunscreen Policy

Summer is here and so is the potential for sunburn. During our summer events, we like to apply sunscreen to the children in the afternoon. We hope parents are applying sunscreen in the morning before school and we can reapply it after lunch.

Please send your child with a bottle of sunscreen labeled with their name. Some children are sensitive to certain types of sunscreen so please, send the type your child can use. Hats are recommended, as well.

In addition, please send bottled water with your child daily. We want the children to stay hydrated throughout the summer. We have a drinking fountain for those children who don't bring in bottled water.

With this in mind, if you are in agreement with our sunscreen policy and would like staff members to assist your child in the application of sunscreen provided by their family, please consent by selecting yes on the summer program registration form.
