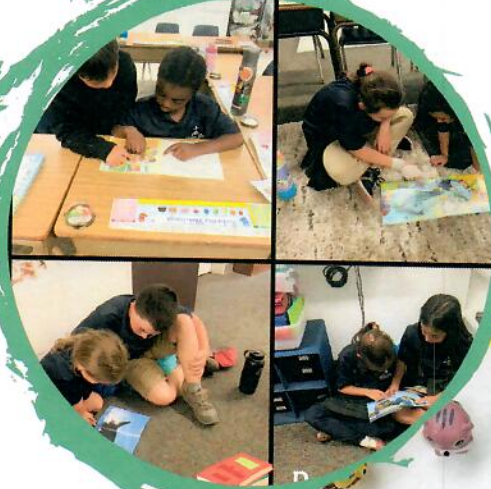
Fun Incentives!
